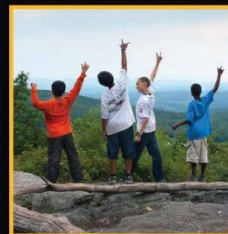

I am warmly grateful to the SCOPE community for recognizing me with the Ben Appelbaum Advocate for Youth Award. In 1980 I joined AIFS' College Division promoting study abroad programs. In June, I helped at the Camp America arrivals hotel. I found the program brimming with youthful energy, adventure, and excitement. I seized the opportunity to join the program in April of 1982 as placement coordinator. The camp counselor in me prevailed, and I couldn't have arrived at a better time!



There were just 1,350 participants that year. AIFS added a support staff program in 1985, the year of my promotion to Director and our first Camp Directors' Fairs. Exponential growth quickly followed. By 1989 there were 8,435 participants for a seven-year growth rate of 625%. This pre-internet, labor-intensive decade paved the way for ongoing innovations and successes that continue to present day. Kudos to my colleague Janet Henniker-Talle of AIFS London and to the amazing global Camp America community.

Camp America sponsored the very first SCOPE banquet and we perennially support the program both professionally and on a personal level.

My staff in Stamford is awesome, as are AIFS support departments. As a Sr. Vice-President I oversee client relations, operations, matching, program support, and crisis management. As Responsible Officer I am accountable for participant health, safety and welfare, regulatory compliance, advocacy, and interface with the Department of State.

I joined AIFS with a degree in Education and the company helped me earn a MBA in 1996. I met my wife Andrea at AIFS. I am eternally grateful for this lifelong opportunity to fuse my passion for cultural exchange with the magical enterprise of summer camp.

Andrea teaches Spanish language and culture. Our son Brendan was a special needs counselor and is launching a promising career in media production. We live in Woodbridge, Connecticut.

Julia Goldman is a senior at Eleanor Roosevelt High School on the Upper East Side. She comes into the SCOPE office weekly to support fundraising efforts, create informational slideshows and compile SCOPE camper content. In addition, Julia serves as a member of the Junior Leadership Council (JLC) where she attends meetings and plans events that help teens who want to give back through SCOPE. At the benefit dinner last April, Julia sold raffle tickets and helped contribute the event's success. Julia not only volunteers with SCOPE, but also in her school's mission to raise money for Zim Kids, a nonprofit that helps orphans in Zimbabwe.



In the summer of 2017, the SCOPE team came to speak at Camp Taconic where Julia had been a camper for seven years. As a Leader In Training (LIT), Julia's age group spearheaded a camp-wide walkathon to raise money for SCOPE. When she learned more about the organization, she knew she had to get more involved. Relating to the NYC public school students SCOPE helps, as she attends public school herself, Julia was inspired to reach out to Molly to secure an internship as soon as she got home from camp. Drawing from her own experiences with SCOPE, Julia was able to inform the LITs, an age group younger than her, about SCOPE and possibilities of involvement when it was their turn to lead the camp in the walkathon.

Julia is excited and honored to be receiving the Jefferson and SCOPE Leadership awards. She would like to thank Molly, Heather and Choi for allowing her to find a place in the SCOPE community and giving her opportunities to learn more about communications and fundraising. She would also like to thank the Camp Taconic community for providing a connection to SCOPE and teaching her the value of camp through activities, counselors and friendship. Camp takes children out of their comfort zones, providing them an escape from the pressures, responsibilities, and stress that consume them during the school year – Julia loves that she has a role in allowing others to experience the impact of summer camp.

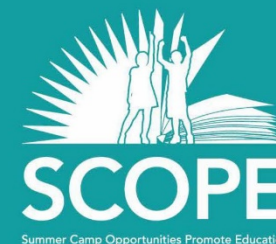

We are honored to be honored, and we share this with and attribute this great award to our entire Tyler Hill Camp family.



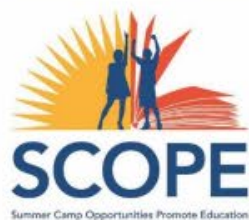
