SCOPE (Summer Camp Opportunities Promote Education) is an independent, nonprofit organization that has provided more than 25,000 camp scholarships to children from underserved communities since 1991.

SCOPE's mission is to provide children from underserved communities with life changing opportunities through the experience of summer camp. SCOPE funds camp scholarships "camperships" to send children who commit to staying in school to nonprofit, resident camps which will empower them to develop to their full potential.

Each year hundreds of children in need receive the benefits of summer camp through funds raised from foundation and corporate partners as well as individual gifts and special events.

The Children We Serve

Summer camp programming can greatly benefit all children, but it plays a critical role in helping children from underserved communities to thrive. While middle to upper-class children often enroll in summer camp or other summer enrichment programs that strengthen and reinforce learning, the vast majority of children from lower-income communities have little or no access to such opportunities.

SCOPE believes summer camp can reinforce what is learned at school, and enhance overall academic learning, in addition to helping children to grow emotionally, to develop leadership and communication skills, and to explore their natural environment at camp.

SCOPE campers make a commitment to stay in school, which will ensure their success as contributing members of their communities and society.
