



Dayna is very involved in leadership roles within the camp industry. She is the Vice Chair of the American Camp Association (ACA) and the past President of the Midwest Association of Independent Camps (MAIC). Dayna is also the co-founder and Chair of SCOPE Midwest (Summer Camp Opportunities Promote Education). She is a speaker at youth conferences across the country on topics ranging from leadership, homesickness, youth development, facility management, difficult conversations, trends in camping, and more.
