The Ben Appelbaum Advocate for Youth Award is given annually to an individual or organization that demonstrates a commitment to improving the lives of children.

LISA LOEB

Lisa Loeb is a GRAMMY™ Award-winning singer-songwriter, touring musician, voice actor, SiriusXM radio host, and philanthropist. She first rose to global prominence with her platinum-selling hit “Stay (I Missed You)” from the Reality Bites soundtrack, becoming the first artist to top the Billboard Hot 100 without a recording contract—a landmark moment for an independent artist.



Over the course of her career, Lisa has released 15 albums, including fan-favorite classics Tails and Firecracker, authored two illustrated books, launched and oversees the Lisa Loeb Eyewear line, and appeared across film and television. She remains a dynamic, multi-hyphenate artist dedicated to creativity, connection, and community. Her most recent studio album, A Simple Trick to Happiness, was praised for its warmth and introspective songwriting, with Rolling Stone calling it “a masterclass in personal storytelling.”

In 2024-2025, Lisa toured extensively across the U.S., performing with artists including Lyle Lovett, Melissa Etheridge, Straight No Chaser, and Patton Oswalt. She also performs with old-time folk band The Hollow Trees, with whom she released the album That’s What It’s All About, celebrating classic songs she grew up with alongside original, family-friendly music.

Growing up in Texas, Lisa loved spending summers at day camps and later at sleepaway camp at Camp Champions in Marble Falls, TX. Inspired to share her love of camp, she recorded favorite camp songs and originals for the Camp Lisa album, which led to the creation of the Camp Lisa Foundation. The foundation helps make sleepaway camp possible for children who might not otherwise get to experience it, with proceeds primarily supporting SCOPE, whose mission closely aligns with Lisa’s own.

The SCOPE Leadership Award has been renamed in honor of Molly's 10 years of service as SCOPE's Executive Director. The award recognizes a member of the SCOPE Associate Board or Junior Leadership Council who demonstrates exceptional commitment to improving children's lives through fundraising and advocacy that expands access to overnight summer camp for youth from low-income families and under-resourced communities.

JANA KISLIN

Jana Kislin, a high school student from Morristown, NJ, first became involved with SCOPE at 11 years old. Inspired by her deep love for camp and desire to give back, Jana began raising money by making and selling bracelets at her dance recital so that other children could experience the same sense of belonging and growth that camp gave her. She later expanded her efforts through additional initiatives such as "Skiing for SCOPE," continuing to find creative ways to support SCOPE's mission.



Motivated by her passion for helping others and her belief in the power of camp, Jana joined the SCOPE Junior Leadership Council (JLC) as a freshman in high school. She quickly became an active and dedicated member, serving as Vice President and ultimately being selected as Co-Chair. In these roles, Jana has led fundraising efforts, contributed to outreach and social media initiatives, and worked to grow awareness of SCOPE within her community and camp network.

In summer of 2025, Jana deepened her commitment to SCOPE by creating an internship. Working in the SCOPE office alongside the professional team, she gained firsthand insight into day-to-day operations. Jana helped reorganize the office and contributed ideas to enhance SCOPE's social media presence, many of which were implemented. Her experience allowed her to see the direct impact of her work and strengthened her passion for SCOPE.

Jana feels incredibly honored to be recognized as the first recipient of the newly named Molly Hott Gallagher Leadership Award. She is deeply grateful



to the SCOPE team for supporting her growth and valuing her voice and contributions. Camp has played a transformative role in Jana's life, giving her confidence, lifelong friendships, and a strong sense of self. She is especially thankful to her family for giving her the opportunity to attend camp and for encouraging her commitment to giving back. As she begins her next chapter at the University of Florida this fall, Jana hopes to continue her involvement with SCOPE and work within the Southeast region to further expand her impact and help more children experience the life-changing power of camp.

This prestigious annual recognition is given to one summer camp or camp program in celebration of their generous commitment to SCOPE. The SCOPE Board of Directors nominates and votes on a camp whose contributions to SCOPE throughout the year are influential beyond the borders of summer.

CRESTWOOD COUNTRY DAY CAMP

Summer camp changes lives.

For ten months, children go to school to learn academics, but for two magical months, children learn to be better people at camp. Ever since 1956, when Crestwood Country Day Camp first opened their doors, the vision has been to change lives and to grow confident kids, one moment, one friendship, one summer at a time. Where else but summer camp can one day include a camper dunking their head in a pool for the first time without getting water back in their nose, scoring a winning goal in soccer, and bravely taking a step off the zipline platform with a bunch of friends cheering them on? The power of summer camp is incredible.

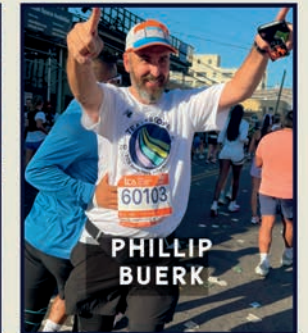

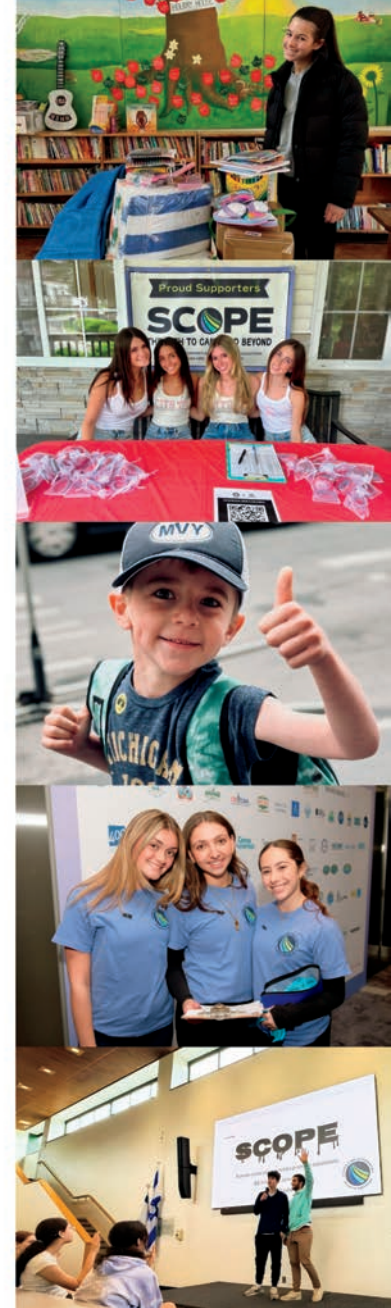

MARK "Z" ZIDES

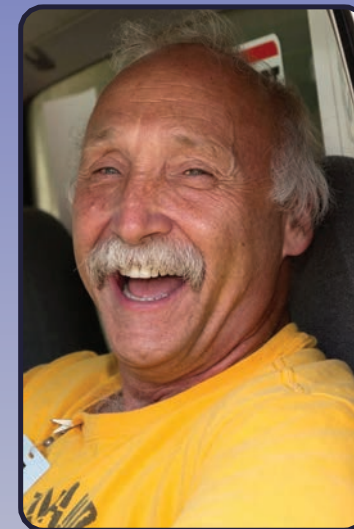
In February 2026 the camping world and the Camp Towanda family lost Mark "Z" Zides, one of the great ones.
